## 1. CONTROLLER

## 2. GENERAL NOTES

This website can be visited without disclosing personal data. Personal data is only collected if you provide it voluntarily — for example by sending an email or filling out a contact form. Transmission is encrypted via TLS.

## 3. HOSTING

This website is hosted by Vercel. Technically necessary server log files are collected (IP address, timestamp, user-agent, requested URL). These data are processed to ensure security, stability, and compliance with legal obligations (Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR).

## 4 . C O O K I E S

This website does not use tracking cookies. Only technically necessary cookies (e.g. for storing language preferences) are used.

---

## 5 . A N A L Y T I C S

This website uses Umami Cloud (operated by Umami Software, Inc., United States) for privacy-friendly reach analysis. Umami is cookieless, does not create cross-session user profiles, and does not collect personal data such as names or email addresses. Only aggregated, non-identifying data is recorded — for example the page visited, the referrer, screen size, browser language, and an approximate country derived from the IP address. The IP address itself is not stored. Anonymous page-load performance metrics (e.g. response time, DOM and load timings from your browser's Navigation Timing API) are also collected to help identify slow pages.

Requests to the tracker are routed via the first-party path `/stats` on this domain, so your browser does not contact `umami.is` directly.

The legal basis is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR (legitimate interest in understanding how the website is used). You may object at any time by blocking the `/stats` path in your browser or via a content blocker.
